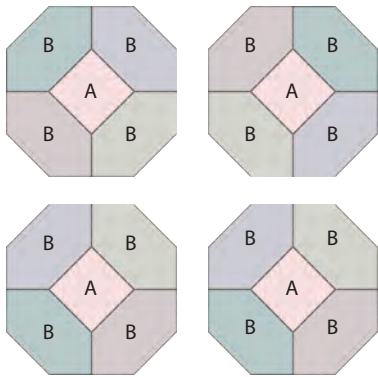
This block is primarily made with Y-seams. Instead of sewing from fabric edge to fabric edge as in many patchwork blocks, you will only sew from dot to dot on the patches and back-stitch to secure.

This is a great hand piecing project.

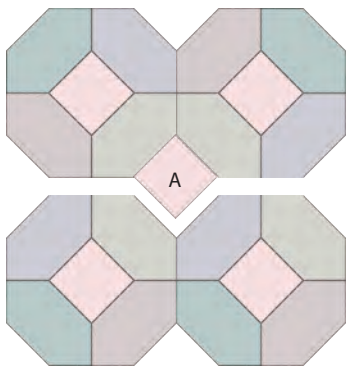
Although the A pieces are all on-point, cutting them on grain as shown will help to stabilize the bias of B. The outer C and D pieces will also stabilize the block.



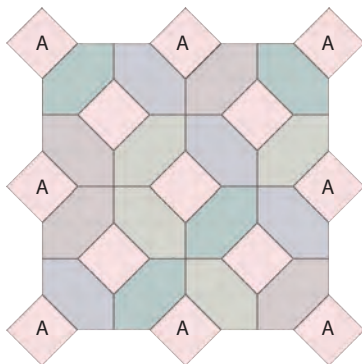
# Assembly



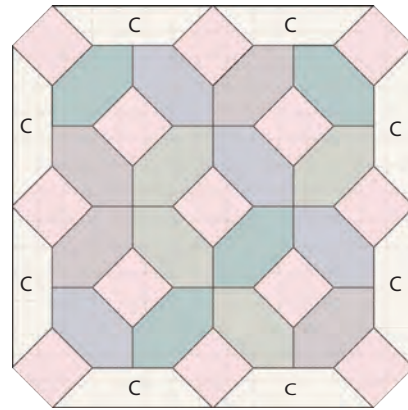
Create four units as shown using the A and B pieces.



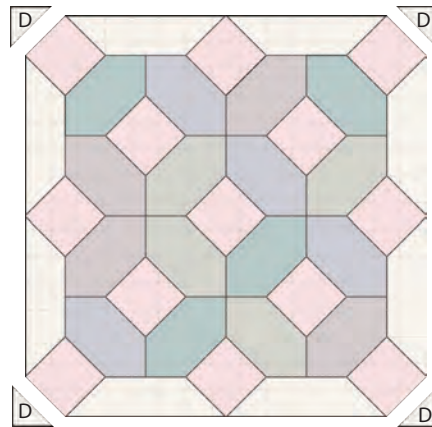
Join as shown setting in the center A piece. Then join top unit to the bottom unit.



Set in the A pieces to the sides and corners.



Set in the C pieces on all sides.



Add the D corner triangles to complete the block.

Other assembly options are available. Do what is most suitable for you.
